We recognise that not all these attainment results compare favourably with National figures. However, progress in reading and maths was above the national for these children from their starting points. With only six children in this cohort, it is not appropriate for us to give a public explanation for the writing progress result and some attainment results in case this information leads to the identification of individuals. The school has a full understanding of this cohort and plans moving forward to ensure children make good progress in writing.
