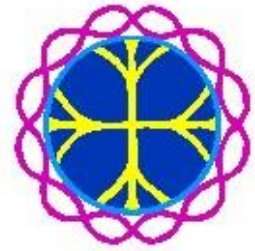

Please can you ensure that this is completed for all children individually and by Wednesday 21st July.

If your child is moving from Tiger Class to Lion Class and you are not eligible for Free School Meals you will need to arrange to pay for the meals your child orders. The cost of meals is £2.30 per day and needs to be paid for by BACS payment directly into the school account. You can choose to pay for meals weekly or half termly, whatever suits you best.
