

**Jaguar Class** – This half-term our topic is **The Tudors**

**R.E.** – In R.E we will be looking into the question 'What does it Mean if God is holy and loving?' We will find evidence to support why Christians believe God is holy and loving from sources such as the bible, Christian architecture and the way they worship.

**French** – In French we will recap previous vocabulary knowledge before going on to learn new vocabulary around hobbies and how we spend our weekends. This will include vocabulary in telling the time and giving our opinion.

**Maths** – This half-term we will continue the learning we began on algebra including forming and solving equations. We will then do some work on fractions including adding, subtracting and multiplying them, before moving on to learning about decimals and percentages.

**P.E** – P.E. returns to being on a Thursday this half-term. Please come into school on Thursdays dressed in your PE kit.

**Science** – In science we will be investigating forces. We will learn about and complete experiments based around gravity, friction, air resistance and water resistance before looking into gears, pulleys and levers. Throughout our experiments we will think about conducting a fair test and using as much scientific vocabulary as possible.

**SATs Week** – This half-term the week continuing 9<sup>th</sup> May is SATs week for the year 6 pupils. I would like to wish them good luck – I know they will be amazing!

**English** – This half-term we will be looking at the book *The Viewer* by Gary Crew and Shaun Tan. This picture book will allow us to make lots of links to prior learning, particularly in history, as well as thinking about how to make our writing more visual and mysterious.

**Art/DT** – This half-term we will be focussing on skills in textiles. We will learn skills in techniques such as batik, tie dying, and fabric painting. Sometimes we will link this to your topic using inspiration such as Tudor family crests and seals.

**History** – To link with our topic, our history this half-term will focus on Tudor England. We will begin by understanding how and when within British history the Tudors were in reign before learning about Tudor religion, schools, clothes, entertainment, discoveries and explorers. This will help us to gain a good understanding of what life was like in Tudor England before we move on next half-term to learn about the significant figures from this time period.

**PSHE** – In PSHE we will be focussing on the topic of relationships. We will discuss all the different types of relationships you can have throughout your life and how many different types of families there are, how your relationships can change over time, how powerful your words can be within a relationship, consent and peer influence.
